Finally, medical professionals must integrate newly learned techniques into clinical practice for at least six months, and pass all written and oral exams.

Becoming a board certified physician is an achievement available to select individuals committed to becoming recognized in their field of medicine. A.A.O.P.M. works with its members to ensure successful completion of all requirements, including proficiency during the hands-on portion of the training, and to receive a passing score on the practical exam provided at the conclusion of each program.

Board certification in a specific field of medicine or medical aesthetics offers numerous benefits for doctors, as well as patients. Medical professionals will have the opportunity to take their skills to the highest level within their specific specialty, while patients have the benefit of knowing they have a highly-trained medical professional working on their case.
