"Supporting the local economy is important to me," explains Such. "All of our new starters live locally, and we're very proud to work for a lot of local businesses in manufacturing, construction and distribution, as well as further afield."

Kitted out with modern IT infrastructure and furnishings, Azzure IT moved in to the new building on the 26th July, joined by the new starters.
