Metal buildings systems are often clad with metal roofs and walls. A metal wall system has a standard insulation range from R-16 to R-32, and metal roofing has been proven to lower the urban heat island effect. According to a study by Ducker Worldwide, metal also lasts longer than most other materials."

Thomas Castellanos responds, "While this report assesses the overall value of metal materials for entire buildings, it is important to also take note of how significant improvements can be simply by using these resources in roofing alone. With many concerns over rapid construction, energy costs and environmental protection, it is important that all builders, developers and property owners understand how many long-term benefits metal roofing--and other metal construction materials--can deliver."
