E-notary providers, independent e-notaries and other companies that create e-notarized documents can upload the basic Metadata about every e-notarized act they create on Notary Trust Registry, and this information can be accessed by the Federal, State, County or Local government institutions and companies such as banks, lenders, investors, etc. to instantly validate the event and document. To keep the information safe and maintain its integrity, the Registry has strict security regulations and guidelines, and no private data is collected in the registry. A unique security key and login details are provided to every user for sending or accessing the registry data.

To enhance the level of trust and peace of mind, a fingerprint of the document or its unique Secure Hash Algorithm (SHA) digest is also added with the metadata, which can be compared to verify that the document is real and trustworthy. The name, commission info and other relevant data of the notary is also available in the registry.

The registry is currently free to use, and adding or accessing the e-notarized data can easily be done by utilizing both the SOAP and REST based protocols. Members also have the control to easily and quickly integrate the registry into any existing web or client based applications.
