

National Park Service Greenlights Concessions

BEDFORD, Va., Oct. 12, 2013 /PRNewswire-USNewswire/ -- The National Park Service sent a letter to Delaware North Companies today permitting the concessioner to re-open Peaks of Otter Lodge just in time for the Blue Ridge Mountains' fall colors. Peaks of Otter is one of just four concessions nationwide within the park system open for tourists during the government shutdown.

Just two weeks ago, Peaks of Otter hosted a grand opening celebration with Virginia Tourism Corp. and local, state and federal officials supported by Rep. Bob Goodlatte (R-VA). Governor Bob McDonnell

enjoy." Peaks of Otter Lodge does a majority of its annual business during the fall colors season from October into early November so re-opening in the first year of Peak's operation was critical, he added.
