1.) Proximity to the collection site

It's usually more expensive to hire a skip bin rental service that's further away from your location compared to one that's nearby, simply because they will have to use up more time and fuel to get to the location. However, this might not always be the case, especially if the skip bin renter has a good logistics system or if the company's business model allows them to offer lower rates.

2.) Rubbish quantity

The more rubbish you have, the more it usually costs to dispose of. The skip bin hire company will have to either make more trips or rent out larger skips, either of which will usually cost more. There is also more labour involved in disposing of larger quantities of rubbish, which means that more work hours need to be paid for an expense that is normally passed on to the skip bin renter in some way.

3.) Type of rubbish

Some types of rubbish may require special handling, as in the case of construction materials

and e-waste. In some cases, this may necessitate higher rates for these types of waste. However, the skip bin rental service may just absorb this higher expense or slightly increase the rates for all offered services to compensate.

4.) Collection frequency

Generally speaking, skip bin hire prices go up when the business has to perform more trips. However, the skip bin rental business may decide to offer the renter a discount in exchange for more frequent business, which often means the cost per collection can be lower. Of course, this all depends on your agreement with your chosen skip bin service.

5.) Value-added service expenses

If a skip bin hire company wants to offer something extra or to further improve its capabilities, they may sometimes need to raise their rates to stay profitable. For instance, if a bin hire company decides to specialise in the disposal of hazardous materials, it will have to invest in training and new equipment. This can sometimes mean higher rates later on. In these cases, it's worth considering the value you are getting in return, rather than just the price of the service in dollars.

The cost of doing business varies dramatically throughout Australia.
