Teaching about head lice in a school environment is particularly important because lice are most common in elementary school children. Also, lice-and especially nits-are commonly mistaken for dandruff. The most conclusive diagnosis comes from finding an adult louse.

Characteristics of Lice

Lice have three stages of development: egg, nymph, and adult.

Egg: Lice eggs, also called nits, are oval-shaped and cling tightly to hair shafts. They are usually located no more than ¼ inch above the base of the scalp.

Nymph: Nymphs are adolescent lice. Nymphs take about 9-12 days to become full adults. Like adults, they survive by consuming blood from the human scalp.

Adult: Adult lice can live on a human head for up to 30 days with no treatment. A full-grown louse is no bigger than a sesame seed.
