When the property became available, they purchased it, and have not looked back since. Currently, Stable Strides Farm provides riding instruction to over 50 riders with a broad spectrum of disabilities and their hunter/jumper riding program has over 60 riders taking lessons and attending competitions.

Mr. McKenzie has developed and strengthened his current business experiences through the skills and leadership techniques that he has learned throughout the beginning of his career. He had a 23-year-career in merchandising with GameStop and its affiliates. For the last eight years in merchandising, he served as the senior vice president of the department. His team of 25 employees purchased, allocated and managed the replenishment of more than \$4.5 billion in video game merchandise. He was also responsible for the development of a retail digital distribution business for downloadable content and games for U.S. operations. Looking ahead, Mr. McKenzie will be looking to get involved in more nonprofit organizations.
