Duraskirt Concrete Skirting Kits are available in two finishes, Traditional Smooth and Northwest Aggregate. Northwest Aggregate is often called pebble skirting, stone skirting or rock skirting because of its textured finish. Traditional Smooth is [mobile home skirting](#) that looks like a standard concrete foundation.

As is to be expected, Duraskirt Concrete Skirting Kits are engineered to meet the HUD Permanent Foundation Code. Each Duraskirt engineered panel is 30" x 37" x 3/4" and made with 6 1/2 sacks concrete mixture and additives, with 1" x 1" galvanized reinforcement and geotextile fabric poured in one end.

When Creative Concrete Products, LLC first introduced the Hidden Vent system in the Northwest, it was well received by existing Duraskirt customers and has been a staple included with the DIY kit ever since. Although aesthetically pleasing, the "Hidden Vent" by Duraskirt serves an important function and the aesthetics are a bonus incorporated into the design. The Hidden Vent system allows even airflow from one side of the home to the other

without the need for vent wells leaving no dead air space, but still meets all requirements for ventilation. The Hidden Vent system also avoids backfill restrictions of any kind.
