Surgical mesh eroded through the vaginal wall about 11 percent of the time over the course of the seven year research study, and "was less effective than desired as a standard criterion procedure for pelvic organ prolapse," according to the JAMA.*

"We hear from several women daily who believe they are suffering from the alleged side effects of transvaginal mesh products manufactured by a handful of companies," said Rochelle Rottenstein, principal of the Rottenstein Law Group LLP. "Erosion, which is cited in the study, is the most common side effect alleged."
