Ms. Batho received a research master's degree in media audiences and another in creative writing, both with honors from University of Western Sydney. In recognition of her achievements, she was recognized with the Ditmar Award for writing and editing, the A. Bertran Chandler Award for science fiction, an Australian postgraduate award to support full-time studies, and numerous FanQ awards for writing and editing.
