"Lynne Mitchell dedicated her life to making a positive difference in other people's lives," says Marlene Gordon, president of the Lynne Mitchell Foundation. "We hope the 'Night Under the Stars' gala will help continue her legacy of showing love to the children in this very poor and rural community in Jamaica and significantly help improve their lives and future potential by providing them a better education."
