

Rochester Dental Offers Insight Into Tooth Loss And Dental Implants In Troy

Whether a patient is missing a single tooth or multiple teeth, Drs. Halsey and Carmody offer dental implants for Troy, MI patients.

The use of dental implants allows these dentists in Troy to successfully replace missing teeth for improved strength and durability. There are a variety of dental implants that can be used to replace single, multiple, or full mouth gaps from missing teeth. At Rochester Dental in Troy dental implants can also be used in conjunction with crowns, bridges and dentures in replacing missing teeth.

"When a patient has missing teeth, it can take a toll on their self-esteem and their bite. It can make an individual look older and cause difficulties in eating. However, no matter what the reason is for tooth loss, dental implants are available to help restore a patient's appearance and functionality of their smile," said Dr. Debra Halsey about patients in Troy with dental implants.

A single tooth implant with crown restoration is the best permanent solution that looks and functions just like a natural tooth. Single dental implants are done when one tooth is missing. Having a crown on an implant is similar to having crowns done over an existing tooth. A laboratory-milled abutment is screwed into the implant posts and acts as the "stump" that holds the crown.

When a patient has more than one missing tooth, multiple dental tooth implants are performed. If there are missing gaps together, dental implants accompanied by dental bridges may be done. If there are missing gaps in separate locations, then individual single tooth implants with a dental crown or a combination of implants with crowns and dental bridges may be used in replacing the gaps.

Full mouth dental implantation is performed in cases where patients have no existing teeth left or for cases where the removal of all existing teeth is needed. A combination of full arch dental implants may be performed in reconstructing both arches. This allows patients to have a new set of teeth, ultimately improving their quality of life.
