Bush and enacted on April 20, 2005, the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act, or BAPCPA, instituted significant changes to the Bankruptcy Code of the United States. Largely regarded as a triumph for the banking industry, the BAPCPA has several new provisions affecting bankruptcy filers.

Essentially, the New Bankruptcy Law (as the BAPCPA is sometimes referred to), makes it more difficult for some debtors to file for bankruptcy under Chapter 7. Most consumer debts are discharged by a successful Chapter 7 bankruptcy filing. Under the BPACPA, more debtors are constrained to file for bankruptcy under Chapter 13, which requires debtors to repay some portion of their debts before their financial obligation can be discharged.
