

LidoChem Wins Long Standing Court Case

(PRLEAP.COM) GRAND RAPIDS, MI - Stoller Enterprises, Inc., Jerry Stoller and David Alexander were found guilty of violating the Lanham Act by intentionally spreading falsehoods about LidoChem, Inc. and its [Performance Nutrition products](#) and tortuously interfering with business relationships by a jury trial in the United States District Court Western District of Michigan Southern Division (Case Number: 1:09-CV-204) presided by the Honorable Robert J.
