According to WIN Founder, Phyllis Stuart "The WIN Awards advance gender parity by honoring both male and female media artists who create dimensional female media images. The WIN Awards exist because to the extent that women's voices remain silent we are all robbed of the contribution. Until women and girls are liberated from poverty and injustice, world peace and sustainable development remain in jeopardy".

Of her WIN honor Living Legend Honoree, **Cecilia DeMille Presley**, said "My grandfather, Cecil De Mille, was a great believer in the artistic value of women. He was famous for hiring women screen writers, researchers and assistant directors, in all facets of film, from the first silent films on. He taught me the value of being a woman, and an activist".

, required show tunes for after dinner entertainment, her sister June directed neighborhood productions, and her mother, a life-guiding lead, encouraged hymns and harmony. Ambassador Hunt shares WIN's goals and for fifteen years, has fought sex trafficking saying, "I envision a world in which every person is valued. No lives are discarded as statistics. No one is marginalized." Moreover, in 2005,

and her sister Helen LaKelly Hunt galvanized female donors, inspiring bolder levels of giving through Women Moving Millions, a pioneering approach to philanthropy through which nearly 200 donors have pledged hundreds of millions of dollars to organizations and initiatives that support women and girls worldwide.
