As a computer scientist, he has held five patents in computer systems and has developed a means to create a sentient, a "thinking computer".

Mr. Sills is the founding sponsor of the Walter and Leonore Annenberg Presidential Learning Center at the Ronald Reagan Presidential Library and Museum in Simi Valley, California. He ran a humorous campaign for President as the "Children's Party" write-in candidate for President in the 1980's. Mr. Sills currently lives in Florida and continues to write.
