Smith announces that a class action lawsuit has been filed in the United States District Court for the Northern District of California on behalf of a class (the "Class") comprising all purchasers of the securities of Velti plc ("Velti" or the "Company") (NASDAQ:VELT) between January 27, 2011 and August 20, 2013, inclusive (the "Class Period").

The Complaint charges Velti and certain of the Company's executive officers with violations of federal securities laws. Velti engages in the provision of mobile marketing and solutions for brands, advertising agencies, mobile operators, advertising technology and and media companies primarily in Europe, the Americas, Asia, and Africa. The Complaint alleges that throughout the Class Period, the defendants made false and/or misleading statements, as well as failed to disclose material adverse facts about Velti's statements and reported financial results, including: (1) that the Company was having difficulties collecting certain receivables; (2) that certain of the Company's were uncollectible; (3) that, as a result, the Company's revenues and receivables were overstated during the Class Period; (4) that the Company lacked adequate internal and financial controls; and (5) that, as a result of the foregoing, the Company's statements and reported financial results were materially false and misleading at all relevant times.

No class has yet been certified in this action. Until a class is certified, you are not represented by counsel unless you retain one. If you purchased Velti securities during the Class Period, you have certain rights, and have until October 21, 2013 to move for lead status. To be a member of the class you need not take any action at this plaintiff or you may retain counsel of your choice.
