(“L&L Energy” or the “Company”) (NASDAQ:LLEN) securities between September 11, 2012 and September 18, 2013 (the “Class Period”) have until November 22, 2013 to file a motion to be appointed as lead plaintiff in the shareholder lawsuit filed in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York.

L&L Energy engages in the production, processing and sale of coal in the People’s Republic of China. The Complaint alleges that the Company issued false and/or misleading statements and failed to disclose material facts concerning the Company’s business, operations and financial performance. Specifically, the Complaint alleges that the defendants misrepresented or failed to disclose that:

- The Company improperly accounted for substantial revenue from operations that were already shut down.
- The Company claimed acquisitions and divestitures of various properties through swap transactions that never occurred, through the exchange of assets it actually never owned.
- The Company lacked adequate internal and financial controls.
- As a result of defendants’ misrepresentations and omissions, L&L Energy’s financial results were materially false and misleading at all relevant times.

If you are a member of the Class described above, you may move the Court no later than November 22, 2013 to serve as lead plaintiff; however, you must meet certain legal requirements. To be a member of the Class, you may retain counsel of your choice or take no action and remain an absent member of the Class.
